- 1) The meeting was called to order by Mayor Daryl Behrends.
- 2) Members and Guests Present: Mayor; Daryl Behrends, Council members; Alan Van Dam, Robert Prins, LeRoy Buys, and Faye Schuur; Clerk, Kris Gunnink; Murray County Sheriff Office, Sheriff Steve Telkamp; Guests, Curt Schuur and Dee Telkamp

- 4) Faye Schuur opened the meeting with prayer.
- 5) Faye Schuur moved to approve the Minutes of the August 13, 2018 City Council meeting. Seconded by Bob Prins. Motion carried.
